



Rustfield - Kingdom of Rust (2013)

(2.5 / 6) already exist since 2007 **Rustfield**, With the *Kingdom of Rust* publish their current debut album. The Italians have been doing all the progressive Heavy Metal prescribed next to your strange fetish for rust. First, can the whole thing with songs like *Among The Fields of Rust* and the outstanding *Waxhopes* very well. Partial reminds me the whole vocally at Hansi Kürsch of Blind Guardian, but the Italian quintet comes to the two band founder Davide Ronfetto (songwriter and guitarist) and Andrea Rampa (singer) significantly quieter works.

To this end, the song structures are again more complex, so that they begin to even remember the genre pioneers Dream Theater. After the somewhat weaker *Losing Time* comes with *Love Moan* the second highlight of the CD. In contrast to the somewhat harder *Waxhopes* dominate soulful, peaceful sounds here. But until then achieved level can not be maintained in the following. Only in the case *Run With Me* again comes to some joy. What **Rustfield** the listener with the much too long instrumental *Out of The Blue* (9 minutes!) And the even longer *High Waters* expect, more than heavy going then While there is no shortage of ideas to the Italians here, but just the songs seem so often quite confused. So overall remains a modest overall impression.
