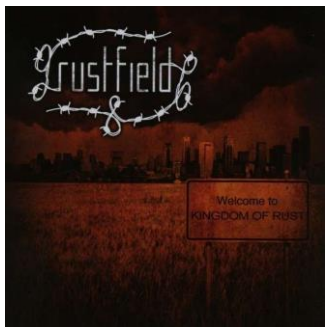

## Rustfield – Kingdom of Rust (2013)

RUSTFIELD is the new five-headed monster coming from Italy to blow up your speakers with a mixture of Progressive Rock and Metal. You can also hear parts of classic Heavy Metal, Electronica, psychedelic elements and acoustic parts. On this debut album guest musicians like John Macaluso (Symphony X, ex-Y.J. Malmsteen), Federica de Boni (White Skull) or Douglas R. Docker (Docer's Guild, ex-Biloxi) are taking part.

The band was founded 2007 by Davide Ronfetto and his friend for many years Andrea Rampa. The concept was and is to build progressive music with different moods and influences. The band was finally build up in 2011 and the record contract was signed in april 2013.

What RUSTFIELD shows up is forceful Heavy Metal, flowing psychedelic melodies, progressive rhythms and fascinating electronical sounds. The eleven songs play for nearly 70 minutes. It's really nice to have that time on an album these days, but sometimes less is more. The musicians would be well advised to just keep some of the short songs inside or on the next album and focus the more progressive cheerful songs. At all it doesn't mean the other ones are bad but in this case they make this album sometimes protractable for the listener. Overall it's a more than solid and interesting album with very much potential. Check out this newcomer! You're going to hear more by them in the next years.
